
The structure of locking systems

hierarchical or centralized

General master key system GH

It consists of locking cylinders with a hierarchical configuration of locking authorities for higher ranking keys. Great general master key (GHS), master group key (OGS), group key (GS) and individual keys (ES).

Master key system (without illustration) The simplest form of a hierarchical system consists of individual keys and a master key which is able to lock all doors.



Central locking system with master key Individual keys (ES) to apartment doors also lock one or more central locking cylinders 2. The master key (HS) only locks central locking cylinders.

Central locking system with one master key superior to all locking cylinders.

Combination of master key with central locking system KHZ (without illustration)
Central locking system with one higher ranking key superior to all locking cylinders.
